# CONFIRMATION OF DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4(1) 15 NOVEMBER 2017

WHEREAS EAST HERTS DISTRICT COUNCIL, being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(5) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015, is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in Schedule One below should not be carried out on land the subject of this Direction being the land shown on the deposited plans and those parcels of land identified by their postal addresses set out in Schedule Two and their extent identified by red edging on the deposited plans, all of them being within the Bishop's Stortford Conservation Area, unless planning permission is granted on an

NOW THEREFORE the said Council, in pursuance of the power conferred on them by Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015, hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below.

THIS DIRECTION was made on the 14 June 2017 under article 4(1) of the said Order and took immediate effect. Representations relating to the Direction were invited by the Council for a period of 28 days and closed on the 14 July 2017. Notice is hereby given that the Council has considered the representations received and has determined to confirm the Direction.

#### Schedule 2, Part 1. Development within the Curtilage of a Dwellinghouse

Class A - The enlargement, improvement or other alteration of a dwellinghouse.

Class C - Any other alteration to the roof of a dwellinghouse.

Class D - The erection or construction of a porch outside any external door of a dwellinghouse.

Class E - The provision within the curtilage of the dwellinghouse of-

(a) any building or enclosure, swimming or other pool required for a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as such, or the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of such a building or enclosure; or

(b) a container used for domestic heating purposes for the storage of oil or liquid petroleum gas.

Class F - Development consisting of-

(a) the provision within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse of a hard surface for any purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as such; or

(b) the replacement in whole or in part of such a surface.

Class G - The installation, alteration or replacement of a chimney, flue or soil and vent pipe on a dwellinghouse.

Glass H - The installation, alteration or replacement of a microwave antenna on a dwellinghouse or within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse.

### Schedule 2. Part 2. Minor operations

Class A - The construction, maintenance, improvement or alteration of a gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure.

Class C - The painting of the exterior of any building or work.

#### Schedule 2, Part 11. Heritage and demolition

Class C - Any building operation consisting of the demolition of the whole or any part of any gate, fence, wall or other means of enclosure.
